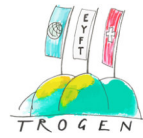

Liceo Ginnasio Statale G.B. Brocchi is a grammar school that was established in 1819. Since then, the school has been continuously innovating its educational offer and teaching methods.

Our school is located in Bassano del Grappa, a small town in the North-East of Italy, not far from Venice and it is attended by nearly 2,000 students, making it one of the largest schools in the region. At Brocchi, as we call it, we offer six different courses to specialize in, namely classical studies, scientific and applied science courses, social studies, modern languages, and socio-economics.

At Liceo Brocchi, developing personal, social, and civic competencies has always been a top priority. Various projects have been undertaken so far, both curricular and extracurricular, such as Social Day, MEP, YPAC, and European projects, which were once called Comenius and Leonardo and are now under Erasmus+.
